The Federal Medical Center, Carswell anticipates a position opening for a Drug Abuse Treatment Specialist in the near future. Duties include the delivery of group and individual psychotherapy and counseling to female federal offenders in an institutional setting. The Psychology Services Department provides comprehensive services including both residential and non-residential drug abuse treatment. The residential program requires 500 hours of participation and includes dual diagnosis and trauma treatment components. Non-residential services involve treatment of drug abuse as well as other addictive behaviors including eating disorders, smoking, gambling and sexual promiscuity. This is a career civil service position with ample fringe benefits. The starting salary with a Masters degree in Psychology or a related field and specified course work is \$45,914 per annum. With a Masters degree including specified course work and appropriate post degree experience, the starting salary is \$53,759 with step increases to \$69,891. Ability to work with the severely mentally ill is required. Correctional or law enforcement experience is not expected.

The Federal Medical Center, Carswell is located on the Naval Air Station - Joint Reserve Base on the west side of Fort Worth. It is comprised of four interrelated facilities which house female federal offenders referred from all parts of the United States: a JCAHO accredited 450 bed medical and mental health center; a 700 bed general correctional unit; a 24 bed high security unit and; a 250 bed minimum security prison camp. The Psychology Services Department consists of seven Psychologists, four Drug Abuse Treatment Specialists and a Technician. The department operates an APA approved predoctoral internship and accepts practicum students from area universities. The institution also employs four psychiatrists and several social workers. Relations among staff in all disciplines are relaxed and collegial.

Due to the law enforcement nature of employment, applicants cannot have reached their 37th birthday.
