Hatcher/Turner Memorial Student Scholarship Application

The Association of Threat Assessment Professionals (ATAP) is a multidisciplinary professional association focused on the prevention of targeted violence attacks. ATAP's multidisciplinary professionals include law enforcement, corporate, education, mental health, behavioral sciences, legal, and security professionals. A scholarship was created in the names of two psychologists whose work in this area has greatly influenced and enhanced the efficacy of approaches involving threat assessment: Chris Hatcher, Ph.D. and James T. Turner, Ph.D.

The goal of the scholarship is to encourage students to focus their work on threat assessment/management and violence risk assessment field, and introduce them to the ATAP community. Up to two recipients are selected every year for this honor and recognition. The conference provides an opportunity to build new relationships and learn of the national dialogue surrounding current trends, approaches, and research relative to threat assessment.

The scholarship recipient will receive a \$2000 award, complimentary conference registration, and airfare, hotel, and ground transportation costs.

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be an undergraduate junior or senior, or a graduate student
- Conduct research, publish, or otherwise contribute to the threat assessment/management or violence risk assessment field
- Major in behavioral sciences, social sciences, or criminal justice
- Submit a completed application form (attached)
- Submit a letter of recommendation from your sponsoring professor
